Who can refer?

- Dentists (GDPs)
- GPs
- School nurses
- Health visitors
- Other healthcare professionals (Speech Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists etc.)
- Self referrals are accepted for housebound patients

We would encourage everyone to seek a GDP in the first instance

CPSCDS explained – What do we do?

- We provide clinical treatment under local anaesthetic, conscious sedation or General Anaesthetic (at the PRUH) along with oral health advice to local people
- We provide Domiciliary visits for those who are unable to leave their house or residential setting
- We deliver Oral Health Promotion in 'under 5' settings, schools, care homes, baby clinics, special needs schools and maintain a supervised toothbrushing scheme across the boroughs of Bexley, Bromley and Greenwich
- We also carry out the British Association for the Study of Community Dentistry (BASCD) dental surveys in these boroughs

CPSCDS explained – Who are we?

- Our service is a **referral only service** for local people who are unable for medical, behavioural or physical disability reasons to access local General Dental Practitioners
- There are strict referral criteria that can be found on our website www.bromleyhealthcare.org.uk
- Level 1 dentistry is completed by General Dental Practitioners (**GDPs**)
- Level 2 dentistry is completed **by us** (dentistry that the GDPs cannot complete)
- Level 3 dentistry is completed in a **hospital setting** if it is deemed necessary (e.g. multi-disciplinary clinics, more complex dentistry)
